

# Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2020

Tingalpa State School will receive

**\$146,816**

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN 'Upper Two Bands' in Reading from 53.6% to 60 % in Year 3 by 2020.
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN 'Upper Two Bands' in Reading from 38.3% to 42% in Year 5 by 2019.
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN 'Upper Two Bands' in Numeracy from 43.5% to 50% in Year 3 by 2019.
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN 'Upper Two Bands' in Numeracy 25.5% to 30% in Year 5 by 2019.
- Progress the STEM initiative in the school to increase the percentage of students achieving an 'A / B' in Science from 66% to 71%.
- Develop Individual Learning Plans for students below 'National Minimum Standard'.
- Increase the number of students in each year level who meet or exceed the Metropolitan Region Reading standard.

## Our initiatives include

- Engage all teaching staff in professional learning to develop whole school pedagogical practices for explicit teaching (pedagogy).
- Use school-based and systemic data to identify students requiring extension / intervention.
- Engage teachers in analysis and discussion of data and develop learning pathways suited to student needs.
- Provide release time to Year Levels to engage in professional learning teams focussed on Reading and Mathematics.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Building Teacher Capability      \$45 000

- Providing professional development -teachers and teacher-aides in explicit teaching practices.
- Purchasing TRS to release teachers to participate in Professional Learning Teams.

Supplementing salaries of key staff      \$80 000

- Employing a Head of Curriculum to embed whole school curriculum plans.
- Employing Targeted Learning Teacher and Teacher Aides to support improvement agenda.
- Purchasing TRS to release Prep Liaison Teacher to establish networks.

Resourcing      \$21 816

- Purchasing additional resources to compliment initiatives.
- Releasing school teams to visit 'like schools' to identify effective teaching practices.
- Engaging experts to deliver programs to students and staff (literacy) \$2600
